Which Full-Time Care Option Is Best?

Level 1: Home Care

Home care may be an option if your loved one is recovering from a surgery or you have family members in the area who are available to provide supplemental care. However, it can quickly become overwhelming and cost prohibitive as your loved one's need for assistance increases.



Level 2: Assisted Living

Assisted living helps your loved one maintain independence while also providing assistance with daily routines such as meal preparation, medication management, hygiene, and mobility.



Level 3: Skilled Nursing Facility

If your loved one needs the daily medical care of a nurse and cannot participate in dressing, bathing, or eating, a skilled nursing facility may be the best option.
